

GENERAL NOTES FOR CODING THIS QUESTIONNAIRE

- 1) Disregard all previous codes which appear in **black** pencil.
- 2) Enter all previous codes which appear in red pencil precisely as they have already been coded, with the following two exceptions:
 - a) if the previous code is "10", change it to "x"
 - b) if the previous code is "11", change it to "y".
- 3) If a particular response cannot be understood, code it as though it was a "no answer" ("x").
- 4) If a number of responses to a particular question are uncodable (do not fit the established codes), do not continue to code that question; check with Roger Kahn.
- 5) If a particular response is especially difficult to code, check with Roger Kahn.
- 6) If the respondent answered "don't know", but then went on to give a response, disregard the "don't know", and code the rest of the response.
- 7) If the code allows multiple-coding to a particular question, there are two separate steps which should be followed carefully.
 - a) Code the first response in the appropriate column on either the 1,2, or 3, card. However, if the first of two or more responses is "other", then and only then code the second response.
 - b) Code the additional responses on the 4 card, which appears directly below the line just coded. Try to enter the multiple codes so that the lowest code appears first (e.g. "1-6-x").
- 8) If there are two or more answers to a question which should have only one code, disregard all answers and code for "no answer". Also, make a note of the specific question and the specific questionnaire (by the questionnaire number), and tell Roger Kahn about it,
- 9) Do all coding with a well-sharpened red pencil. This will make the next step of the study (key punching) much much easier.
